



## CONSULATE GENERAL OF GRENADA

### REQUIREMENTS FOR PROCESSING VISA APPLICATIONS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL IN GRENADA

1. Application **MUST** be completed in **BLUE** or **BLACK** ink.
2. Applications **MUST** be made at least **6 weeks PRIOR** to departure date.
3. The processing time for the application is approximately **7 business days** from date of receipt.
4. Applicant's passport **MUST** be valid for at least **6 months from date of departure from Grenada** and accompany application.
5. Only a **FULLY COMPLETED** Visa Application Form will be accepted.
6. **TWO (2)** Passport pictures (*no more than 3 months old*), one certified by a **Justice of the Peace** or a **Notary Public**.
7. Application for a **Single Entry** Visa is **US\$100.00** per applicant. Application for a **Multiple Entry** Visa is **US\$250.00** per applicant.
  - i. **ONLY CERTIFIED CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS ARE ACCEPTED.**
  - ii. **CASH** accepted **IN PERSON ONLY.**
  - iii. If the Visa is to be mailed back to you, please include a **separate money order** either for **US\$20.00** for Express Mail Service (*within the USA*), or **US\$55.00** for Express International Service. Money order(s) are payable to **Consulate General of Grenada.**
8. U.S. Permanent Residents who require a Visa to visit Grenada must also show proof of permission to re-enter the U.S. (*Please bring your Residency Card with you to the Consulate General or if mailing, photocopy both sides of your card on one page and have it notarized*).
9. Visas are valid for only the period of time specified.
10. Holders of Visas may not work in Grenada unless authorized to do so by the local Ministry of Labour.
11. **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED FOR ISSUANCE OF VISA:**
  - i. Completed Visa Application
  - ii. Passport valid for at least **6 months from date of departure from Grenada**
  - iii. Two (2) passport pictures (*no more than 3 months old*), one certified by a **Justice of the Peace** or a **Notary Public**
  - iv. If you are a Permanent Resident of the US (*Please bring your Residency Card with you or notarized copy - see No. 8 above*)
  - v. One money order for visa fee and if applicable another money order for the return of the passport
